



How To Prepare For Your Treatment

LIVING ROOM, BEDROOMS, CLOSETS ETC



Vacuum all rugs, carpet and upholstered furniture. Vacuum bag should be discarded immediately upon completion.



Any unlaundered wool or natural fibre clothing should be laundered or at least placed in a hot dryer for one hour. Make sure you follow all label recommendations before laundering.



Move all furniture 12" (30 cm) away from the walls. Please be sure to exercise safety first and do not attempt to move very large furniture. Clear items underneath beds on the day of treatment. Items that are not regularly moved are nesting areas for carpet beetles.

٠	DO NOT use other pest control chemicals (powders or sprays) or cleaning products near areas that have been sprayed, as this will decrease or eliminate the effectiveness of the treatments.		Avoid waxing or washing floor surfaces, especially the edges for at least 2 weeks after treatment. Do not steam clean carpets. Vacuum as usual
